- Our metric report has been shared with OBIAA as we are one of the first BIA's to do this.

9. City MYB update

- A few items have been cut from the budget
 - \$100,000 per year for activations
 - o Dundas Place equipment.



- The budget is still set to change. Once Council reconvenes any changes that happen have to have ½ the votes to go into effect.
- Have been able to keep the Downtown Strat Plan this becomes part of the official plan.
- With the new Strong Mayor Power, it is not exactly clear as to when the budget will be fully approved.
- Currently, the tax increase is 8.7% for the first year.

Other:

- New CCTV cameras going in at King wellington/ york/wellington, king/waterloo, York/Waterloo, Market Lane
