- Ongoing issue response and proactive monitoring

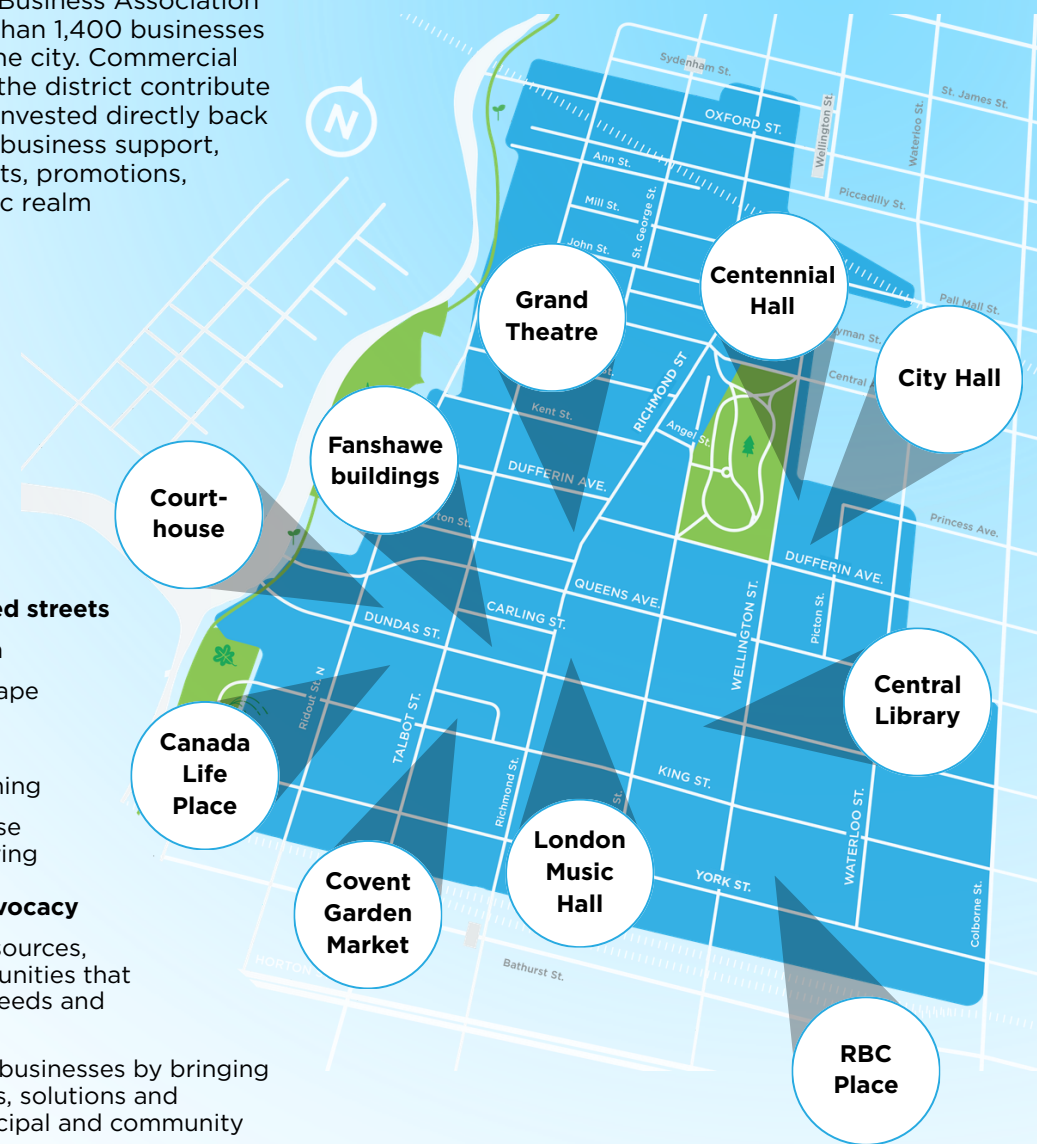
Business support and advocacy
